Life in the Spirit

Live by the Spirit, I say, and do not gratify the desires of the flesh. For what the flesh desires is opposed to the Spirit, and what the Spirit desires is opposed to the flesh; for these are opposed to each other, to prevent you from doing what you want. But if you are led by the Spirit, you are not subject to the law.

Now the works of the flesh are obvious: fornication, impurity, licentiousness, idolatry, sorcery, enmities, strife, jealousy, anger, quarrels, dissensions, factions, envy, drunkenness, carousing, and things like these. I am warning you, as I warned you before: those who do such things will not inherit the kingdom of God.

By contrast, the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, generosity, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control.

Self-knowledge

Self-awareness, and this rather alarming word 'dispassion', are to do with developing some sense of our freedom from the projections, the expectations, the busyness that constantly threaten to hem us in. And we only really get that when, in our prayer and in our life generally, we make enough space to hear our name spoken by God.

The real problem in prayer is not the absence of God but the absence of us. It's not that God isn't there; it's (nine times out of ten) that we are not. We are all over the place, entertaining memories, fantasies, anxieties. God is simply there in unending patience, saying to us, "so when are you actually going to arrive? When are you going to sit and listen, to stop roaming about, and be present?"

The sense that we are connected with something so real that it will break every boundary or container we try to confine it in, a sense of something overflowing, pushing outwards. 'Out of the believer's heart shall flow rivers of living water,' says Jesus in the Gospel of John, about the person who receives the Spirit.

You know what we need before we ask it


You see the hidden desires of our hearts
